The Tomorrow Project suicide bereavement service has been developed directly from the needs of the bereaved to provide a dedicated, innovative new service for those facing this devastating experience.

The pain of grief can sometimes seem too much to bear, but with the right support and guidance, we can find the path to support, understanding and recovery.





The loss of a loved one to suicide is a uniquely devastating circumstance that leaves the bereaved with **unanswered questions** and **complex feelings** that can be hard to understand and process, our service understands this and is here to help.

Following a newly implemented coroner-led system, our service will be able to **communicate with families within 72 hours of their loss**, informing them of our service and allowing us to establish the immediate needs of the family, provide them with the Help is at Hand document and put in place support that responds to their short term and long term needs.

Whether we are needed to help liaise with other services, provide emotional support or help secure practical and financial help to the bereaved.

Our experienced and dedicated support team are here to provide a specialist nation leading service for those left in the dark following the trauma of loss through suicide.
